Worker Responsibility	<p>When in the communities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) When in communities check with the RCMP and Hamlet office to determine if there were any wildlife sightings in the community, as soon as you arrive in the community 2) Be vigilant for wildlife in the community <p>When in Camp:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Check with the management when you arrive and determine any wildlife risks 2) Be vigilant for wildlife at the site.
