
NWISP 2019 Work Plan Highlights

2. Publication Timing






3. 2019 NWISP Data Requests (till October, 2019)











About 95% of the data requests come from Canada and about 46% of the Canadian requests come from Ontario.






About 70% of the data requests are for "research" and "accident or injury prevention" purpose.






3. NWISP Survey Results
