


## A Cautionary Tail



- YWCHSB learned of the situation when doctors submitted reports of suspected lead exposures.
- Their employers were ordered to have them tested for lead exposure.
- By January 2015, YWCHSB had identified 229 visitors to the mine site.
- Of those 229 workers, 96 submitted blood test results. Of those, 10 showed lead-exposure levels high enough to require them to remove themselves from exposure and be medically examined.

**Blood Tests** 

- OHS investigated the matter and in July 2015 fined 4 companies \$37,500. All companies have paid their fines.
- The mill parts are stored in Watson Lake and OHS continues to monitor the activity associated with moving this mill.
- The mill is destined for BC and OHS has made the BC Ministry of Mines aware of the facts surrounding the case.
